

THE ROYAL RESPONSE – PART 2

COVENANT OF THANKSGIVING...Celebrate Jesus!

ISAIAH 56:7: The 3 third pillar of the Biblical Household, make your house a house of prayer.

Beginning last TUESDAY:

- We are going to address Spiritual Warfare and Prayer from the Foundation of OBEDIENCE.
- Instead of being REACTIVE to demonic activity, we will be PROACTIVE via OBEDIENCE.

DECLARATIONS:

- I am ROYALTY with great spiritual AUTHORITY.
- God will bless the nations through my family.
- I win spiritual BATTLES by being OBEDIENT to God.

Every king has a Kingdom = King's Dominion/Domain = a territory or jurisdiction he has rule over.

PRINCIPLE #1 – STAY IN YOUR LANE

- Every believer has royal identity and authority, but there are levels of kingdom jurisdiction.
- Remember, God is King (not you) over your life and family – you stay in your lane.
 - **1 CORINTHIANS 4:1-2**
 - The priests could offer sacrifices, but only the high priest went into the Most Holy place.
 - I am a royal priesthood, but I am not the High Priest – Stay in your lane.
 - Saul offered sacrifices because he did not wait for the Samuel – stay in your lane.
 - Lucifer was beautiful, full of music and powerful but wanted the throne – stay in your lane.
- APPLY TO MARRIAGE, CHURCH, MISSIONS
 - Man: You are the head of the home, but you still answer to God for his children in your home.
 - Woman: You have access to God and have freedom, but the man is the head, and God still does not tolerate rebellion.
 - Pastor: You are head of the ministry, not head of the church. Stay in your lane.
 - Leaders/ Mentors: You lead, and you are a blessing, but you are not the standard – stay in your lane.
 - Spiritual Warfare: Hear God first, secure your home first. Stay out of places, territories, and other people's homes unless invited. WORRY ABOUT YOURSELF – Stay in your lane.
 - Missions: Go where you are authorized to go, do what you are asked, stay in your lane.

QUESTION: I THOUGHT THE BELIEVER HAD ALL AUTHORITY?

YES, but there are levels of capacity and power that come by obedience, training, and preparation.

ILLUSTRATION: A seed versus a bag of seed versus a truck of seeds.

ACTS 19:13-17

1 PETER 5:1-6

PRINCIPLE #2 – DO YOUR JOB

- Do your job well and quit worrying about what someone else is doing or not doing.
- Be secure in your identity and place in God. Your assignment is your role, your identity is of God, DO NOT MIX THE TWO.
- While doing your job/assignment, stop reminding us of who you are and your authority.

DO YOUR JOB ACCORDING TO THESE LEVELS AND YOU WILL MAKE IMPACT:

- Your body and soul: your Temple
- Your wealth, your purpose, your character
- Your home: people and physical location
- **ACTS 1:8:** Go Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, ends of the earth
- Violate the Principles and you going will be difficult, and evil spoken of, and not generational.
