- Custodians of Kingdom Mysteries.

HOW TO USE YOUR ROYALTY: SERVE, INTERCEDE, and ENCOURAGE PEOPLE

FROM THE ROYAL RESPONSE – PART 2

Every king has a Kingdom = King's Dominion/Domain = a territory or jurisdiction he has rule over.

PRINCIPLE #1 – STAY IN YOUR LANE

- Every believer has royal identity and authority, but there are levels of kingdom jurisdiction.
- Remember, God is King (not you) over your life and family you stay in your lane.
 - o 1 CORINTHIANS 4:1-2
 - Operate in the jurisdiction of your calling, grace, and anointing.

PRINCIPLE #2 – DO YOUR JOB

- Do your job well and quit worrying about what someone else is doing or not doing.
- Be secure in your identity and place in God. Your assignment is your role, your identity is of God, DO NOT MIX THE TWO.
- While doing your job/assignment, stop reminding us of who you are and your authority.

MATTHEW 20:1-16

- Stay in your lane you are not Heaven's HR department to decide people's benefit packages.
- You are not judged on the length of your service but on the quality of your job.

• 1 CORINTHIANS 3:12-14

WHO ARE YOU WORKING FOR?

- We say God but we get offended if the work does not come with human respect and glory.
- We say God but we are willing to stop doing our work for God because someone else is not doing their job.
- YOU ARE ROYALTY, ALWAYS ROYALTY, THEREFORE ALWAYS FAITHFUL.

COLOSSIANS 3:23-24

WHAT ARE YOU WORKING FOR?

- We say for the glory of God, but would you continue being faithful to God even when others are being unfaithful?
- We say for the glory of God, but when people do not acknowledge us, we get disappointed.

It is human to desire appreciation, but you must override that craving and need with a royal response: "I already know who I am, your appreciation of me or the lack thereof is your choice, it neither increases nor decreases me."
