COVENANT OF THANKSGIVING...Celebrate Jesus!

1 SAMUEL 16:1-13

- David's heart of worship attracts God to him.
- God rejects King Saul and Samuel the Prophet goes to Bethlehem to anoint David as next King.

1 SAMUEL 16:1

- Though God had rejected Saul as King, He was about to use Him for something greater: TO PURIFY David's worship.
- David had the heart of worship (the theory) of worship uninterrupted and uncorrupted by man.
- David's worship was about to be matured and proven (the practical) in the presence of human activity.

APPLICATION

- We all have expectations and what our ideal family should be.
- Ambitions and dreams are pure until other people's will, and choices come interrupting.
- Will you worship through the storm, discouragement, rejection and abandonment?
 - o That is the test of a True Worshipper

JOHN 6:67-69

PSALM 51:

- David had just committed adultery with Bathsheba. 2 SAMUEL 11
- David in one series of events has destroyed another family.
- David invited the sword and death to his own family.
- David disappointed God: the prophet Nathan brought the convicting judgment of God.
- WHATEVER LIFE THROWS AT YOU, WRITE A SONG AND SING TO THE LORD
 SONG: verses 10-12

DECLARATION: I am a TRUE WORSHIPPER. I WORSHIP THROUGH MY ADVERSITY

PSALM 3

- Absalom has taken over Jerusalem and David is fleeing to save his life.
- His own son and chief advisor had turned on him.
- The family inheritance and glory are gone.

- Resources are limited, there is great discomfort, and the future is uncertain.
- The story is not ending the way you wrote, planned, and prayed it.
- WHATEVER LIFE THROWS AT YOU, WRITE A SONG AND SING TO THE LORD
 SONG: verse 3
