DANIEL 10:12-13

- Daniel could pray with the conviction that it is done, or
- He could pray, doubting if God had heard or cared.

2 KINGS 6:15-17

- What the servant saw with his physical eyes was different from what Elisha saw in the spirit.
- The angels were already there, already complete, the servant could not see.

GENESIS 3:4-5

- Adam and Eve were already complete, and like God **[GENESIS 1:26]**.
- The enemy's strategy is to make you doubt what is already complete.
- The devil is counting on the fact that you do not know what God has revealed.

DEUTERONOMY 29:29

JOHN 4:10

HOSEA 4:6

HEBREWS 11:1-3

- **VERSE 1**
 - Faith is an assurance, confidence, conviction, and certainty of what is not seen.
- **VERSE 3**
 - Distinction between what is unseen, seen, and visible.
 - Seen – βλέπω
 - to see something physical
 - discerned with the bodily eye, look at, behold.
 - NO DOUBT HERE.
 - Visible – φαίνω
 - To lighten, shine
 - Bring forth in light, appear
 - DOUBT APPEARS HERE WHEN VISIBILITY IS LOW.

It is no longer faith when God has already answered. When we do not know what He has already revealed.

WHEN IS DONE, i.e., HAS LEFT THE MOUTH AND PRESENCE OF GOD AS COMPLETE:

1. We do not know if it is complete.
2. We know, but we do not see it in the natural.
3. We know, but the lies, confusion, twists of the enemy, or things we see in the natural fight us.
